Did you know that smoke detectors expire just **like milk?** Check the manufacture date on yours. If it is older than 8-10 years, it needs to be replaced. The testing mechanism for the alarm may still work, but their ability to detect smoke will have diminished. Dust and debris build up in the unit causing failure. Vacuuming your smoke detector once a month can help. Also, change your batteries when you change your clocks for daylight savings (Nov. 5!). Wells Fire Department gave us some batteries. If you need a battery or two, come by the office.



# **How's Your Hearing?**

Hearing Health Presentation by Dr. Matthew Lewandowski, Au.D, CCC-A



According to the American Academy of Audiology, about 36 million American's are experiencing hearing loss. Studies by the Better Hearing Institute suggest that untreated hearing loss can lead to some or all of the following:

- Anger, fatigue, stress and depression
- Avoidance or withdrawal from social situations
- Loneliness
- Reduced alertness and increased risk to personal safety
- Reduced job performance and earning power
- Diminished psychological and overall health

The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) recommends that anyone over the age of 50, **regardless of their hearing status**, should have their hearing screened annually (at least for a baseline).




